Further Education - 2 Year Full Time - Level 3 BTEC

BTEC Level 3 National Extended Diploma in Performing Arts Practice (Dance and Musical Theatre), with intensive professional dance training and optional ISTD Level 4 DDE Dance Teacher Training

Our 2 yr course is primarily but not exclusively aimed at 16-18 year olds wishing to pursue further dance training and qualifications (BA Hons etc) at Higher Education vocational colleges.

Further Education - 3 Year Full Time - Level 4 Diploma

BTEC Level 3 National Extended Diploma in Performing Arts Practice, RSL Level 4 Extended Diploma for Creative Arts Practitioners with intensive professional dance training and optional ISTD Level 4 DDE Dance Teacher Training

Our 3 yr course is primarily but not exclusively aimed at 16-19 year olds wishing to pursue a career in the performing arts. Course is equivalent to the first year of a degree, worth 120 credits. This course can be joined for one year after completing a Level 3.

Higher Education - 2 Year Full Time - Level 5 Diploma

RSL Level 4 Extended Diploma for Creative Arts Practitioners, RSL Level 5 Extended Diploma for Creative Arts Practitioners with intensive professional dance training and optional ISTD Level 4 DDE Dance Teacher Training

Our 2 year course is primarily but not exclusively aimed at 18+, for students aspiring to advance to higher levels of education and professional development in dance. This course is equivalent to the first and second year of a degree, worth 120 credits.

Higher Education - 3 Year Full Time - Level 5 Diploma

Our 3 year course is primarily but not exclusively aimed at 18+, for students aspiring to graudate into a career in the performing arts industry. This course is equivalent to the first and second year of a degree, worth 120 credits.

ISTD DDE Dance Teacher Training (Level 4)

This course is suitable for all learners 16+ (mature learners welcome) and can be studied over 2-3 years part time.

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BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma in Dance or Musical Theatre

A full-time internally assessed Level 3 qualification which includes a Foundation Diploma (equivalent to 1 ½ A Levels), and an Extended Diploma (equivalent to 3 A Levels)

Worth up to 164 UCAS points (D*D*D*)

Pearson BTEC Dance qualifications offer candidates the opportunity to learn about the industry, developing their understanding and practical dance skills, and applying the skills and knowledge in a vocational dance setting. Each qualification prepares learners for the next level of study within the field of Dance, preparing learners for the world of work, formal dance training or university. The qualifications can be delivered as full-time dance training as part of a broad and balanced programme of study. BTEC Dance qualifications can prepare learners to become dancers as well as creators and artists in the community.

Assessment will include demonstration of understanding, development in technique classes and workshops, application of skills in rehearsal and performance and self-review.

This BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma will allow learners to progress onto our Level 4 and 5 courses to continue their study or apply to specialist performing arts schools.

Who are SCL Creative College?

SCL Creative are the official education provider for our BTEC qualification.

Highly trained professional artists and performing arts teachers deliver the BTEC study programme at ElliTe Studios College under the mentorship of SCL Creative and within a wider network of SCL Teachers.

SCL Management staff will be responsible for delivery and managing the quality assurance of the BTEC education programme. This will ensure learners maximise their true potential as they work closely with our industry professionals. Working collaboratively ensures all learners receive high level performing arts training and are working towards achieving the highest grades possible.

All learners will be entitled to the same privileges as any Further Education learner; for example, student bursaries (if eligible), UCAS guidance, pastoral care, education support, FE Enrichment programmes and GCSE re-sit opportunities (if required).

SCL Creative have exceptional success, retention & achievement in Performing Arts in all learning sites!

Learners are required to audition for this education programme and must achieve 5 GCSE's grade 4 and above (including maths and English). If successful at audition, learners will simply apply and enrol with SCL Creative and at our education partner/s.

100% of SCL Creative Learners have positive destinations including successful audition to advance, Performing Arts training schools across the UK, other HE programmes and/or employment, directly into the industry.

ISTD DDE DANCE TEACHER TRAINING



The DDE is an achievable and streamlined initial teacher training qualification offering successful graduates a license to teach within existing dance schools or to open their own, and to enter students for ISTD examinations. Following the DDE qualifications, graduates will be able to further develop their knowledge and skills either immediately or in the future by accessing the Level 6 Diploma in Dance Pedagogy or the Licentiate and then Fellowship qualifications. These further qualifications can allow teachers to follow enhanced and sustainable careers as tutors, adjudicators and examiners as well as providing access to teaching in Primary and Secondary Education. For performers, these skills are similar to those needed for Dance Captain roles.

DDE Level 4 Qualification

The Level 4 Diploma in Dance Education (DDE) Qualification Accreditation Number is 603/3094/6

The qualification is regulated at Level 4 on the Regulated Qualifications Framework and has a credit value of 120.

The Level 4 ISTD DDE is an Ofqual regulated teaching qualification, which provides an excellent introduction to a career in teaching dance. It offers students a clear pathway to becoming a qualified dance teacher with the Imperial Society of Teachers of Dancing and allows the opportunity to engage with up-to-date research in best practices related to dance teaching and learning.

The framework of the assessment ensures that student teachers develop the practical skills and knowledge required to enter the teaching profession, as well as to develop a sustainable career. In studying the DDE, candidates cover a breadth of material, leaving them fully qualified within their chosen dance genre. It lends itself to a blended learning approach combining classroom and studio delivery with online activities and assessments.

Depending on individual experience and the chosen format of studying, the Level 4 DDE can be achieved over a 2-3 year programme, either part-time or as part of our full time vocational training.

It consists of 5 individual units that are written to support the learning from one unit to another preparing the student fully for teaching in the studio.

Unit 1: Preparing for Safe Teaching (15 credits at Level 3)

Unit 2: Observing, Assisting and Teaching Practice (30 credits and Level 4)

Unit 3: Vocational Graded Examination in Dance: Intermediate (28 credits at Level 3)

Unit 4: Dance Practice (30 credits at Level 4)

Unit 5: Social, Emotional and Cognitive Development (17 credits at Level 4)



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
